# HOW TO TAKE PART IN SILENT NIGHT

#### Choose how long.

Pick how long you will stay silent:
Mini: 2 hours, Medium: 6–12 hours, Ultimate: 24 hours.
Set up your fundraising page and let people know in advance what you are doing. Wear a sign or a sticker whilst being silent so people know what you are doing and can donate.


#### Spread the word
